Local Sober Living Residents Handle Moving Duties for Simone Biles Invitational

HOUSTON, TX - Sharpen Recovery, a Houston, TX-based provider of affordable, quality sober living homes for men and women, received the prestigious honor of being selected to handle all move-in and move-out duties for the 2024 Simone Biles Invitational at the George R. Brown Convention Center. The 4-day project saw dozens of Sharpen residents working hard to ensure a successful competition. Zach Francis, General Manager of World Champions Centre which is the home gym for Slmone Biles, selected Sharpen Recovery and its moving company Strategic Moves for this large, multi-day project. The ability for our program participants to come in and work hard, make some money and make a difference was so impactful for them. These are men and women who are focused on recovery, developing a relationship with God and rebuilding their lives. This was a huge moment for them."

Sharpen Recovery opened its first sober living house five years ago, in 2019. In just 5 years, the Sharpen program has expanded to a total of 15 sober living houses serving both men and women. At Sharpen, there is house manager supervision and accountability around each individual's recovery journey, including required recovery meeting attendance, weekly reports, drug/alcohol testing, and more. To date, Sharpen Recovery has helped more than 1,000 men and women along their journey to recovery. Sharpen Recovery homes are located in places such as Richmond, Galveston, Baytown, Spring Branch, Cypress, Sugar Land, Braeswood, Denver Harbor and more.
